

Radical Love: The Spirituality of Dorothy Day



This workshop will provide insight into the personal and public life of Dorothy Day through her autobiography, journals, and articles in *The Catholic Worker*. It will focus on her spirituality and how her faith and values

enabled her to respond to God's calling. Dorothy Day not only read and embraced the Gospel; she lived it by immersing herself in the social issues of the day and by responding to "the least of these."

Through facilitated discussion, reflection, music and journaling, participants will come away with what it means to follow Jesus' commandment to love one another in their own lives. The legacy of Dorothy's dedication and commitment to discipleship is one that continues to, in her words, "create a new heaven and new earth wherein justice dwelleth." Practical suggestions for integrating spirituality and one's own calling will be offered.
